On this team, you will find a positive culture that leads to new professional development opportunities, real world academic education on electoral campaigns, and for yourself with an overall mission to elect Democrats throughout New Jersey.


Your Position with the Campaign

This **Summer/Fall Fellow** is responsible for the facilitation and growth of direct voter contact and engagement. With consideration to state party COVID policy and protocols, this role is expected to be hybrid remote and in person post with a rolling start date of July 1st and thereafter.

This Fellow will have the opportunity to work closely with Forward 2021 Digital Organizing staff, Youth for Murphy, and the AR visual organizing department. Interns report directly to their assigned Digital Organizer, each "turfed" to our texting program, dialer program, social media and relational program.

Responsibilities

- Assist Digital Organizer in day-to-day campaign operations and strategic planning specific to a program
- Work on creative projects to increase online voter and volunteer engagement in the campaign
- Participate in various direct voter contact activities, host events, and contribute to recruitment efforts
- Contribute to the campaign's online presence
- Achieve educational benchmarks set by digital organizers



Minimum Qualifications

- Interest in politics
- No prior experience required
- Ability to work 10-15 hours per week, scheduling is flexible based on your availability
- Strong knowledge of Google Docs, basic computer literacy, and access to a reliable laptop and cell phone
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Commitment to treating all individuals with respect, regardless of background, race, ethnicity, religion, gender identity, sexual orientation, or disability
- Enrolled academic institution accepts campaign fellowships for academic credit or volunteer hours

Desired Qualifications

- Experience in political campaigns
- Interest in and basic understanding of New Jersey politics
- Basic knowledge of Votebuilder/VAN is preferred but not required
- Occasional transportation to and from Newark or Trenton office
- Willingness to be creative and experiment within the scope of the position
- A sense of humor

Program Descriptions

- The Texting Program focuses on utilizing our texting system to reach voters, collect data, and organize text banks.
- The Dialer Program focuses on utilizing our call system to reach voters, collect data, and organize phone banks.
- The Social Media and Relational Program focuses on utilizing relational voting tools like the REACH app, friendbanking, and social media organizing.
