- Drafting and executing creative plans to contact and mobilize voters
- Supporting fundraising and outreach activities
- Managing and executing phone banks, canvasses, text banks, and other voter contact efforts
- Monitoring media coverage and conducting research to guide communications strategy
- Learning to use the Voter Activation Network (VAN), a voter database system utilized by Democratic campaigns across the country
- Staffing the candidates at events across the district

Qualified candidates will have a positive attitude, a willingness to learn, and a desire to make a meaningful impact in their local communities. All are encouraged to apply, regardless of experience. Candidates will be accepted on a rolling basis.
